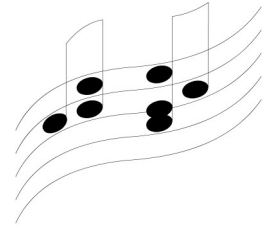


MUSIC & MORE
